All Year 12 exams will take place in the Sports Hall (apart from Music and Art which will take place in a classroom – details of this should be provided by your subject teacher).

• Pupils should go directly to the Sports Hall each morning at 8.45am.

• Pupils should check notices on the door when entering the Sports Hall as there may be special seating arrangements required for each exam.

✤ Break will be from 10.55 – 11.10am. Lunch will be from 1.10 – 1.45 pm.

- Pupils must attend all examination sessions from Wednesday 10th Wednesday 17th January. Pupils must be present in the Sports Hall at all times during the examination period. If pupils do not have an examination during a session, they must use that time for revision. Therefore, all pupils are expected to plan in advance what they are going to revise and **bring suitable revision material** to enable them to study effectively during these times. Pupils who do not bring revision will be provided with other work to do.
- Pupils are not allowed to leave the school premises during the exam period.
- During the examinations, no electronic equipment is allowed in the exam room. All mobile phones, Apple Watches and mp3 players must be left at home or switched off and zipped in schoolbags. Pupils will <u>NOT</u> be allowed to listen to music during revision time as this is not allowed in external exams. Any pupil who is found to be using a mobile phone or electronic device in an examination room will score zero in that exam and be put in detention.
- ◆ During lunch, pupils should stay away from the B block, the H block and rooms L3 L6 as junior pupils will be doing exams in these areas at this time.
- ✤ If you are absent and miss any exams then you must inform your subject teachers on the first day you return to school.
