- ❖ All Year 13 exams will take place in the Assembly Hall (apart from Art & Design more details will be provided by your class teacher).
- ❖ Pupils should go directly to the Assembly Hall each morning at 8.45am.
- * The following times will apply during the examinations:

Morning exam session will be from 8.45 – 1.10pm.

Lunch will be from 1.10 - 1.45pm.

Afternoon exam session will be from 1.45 – 3.20pm.

- Morning exams will begin at 8.45am (there will **NOT** be time for revision before the exam begins) and afternoon exams will begin at 1.45pm. Pupils will NOT be released until the time scheduled for the end of their paper.
- ❖ Year 13 pupils only have to attend school when they have an exam. However, when the pupils do have an exam they must arrive promptly at the Assembly Hall at the times stated above.
- Pupils should check notices on the door when entering the Assembly Hall as there may be special seating arrangements required for each exam.
- During the examinations, no electronic equipment is allowed in the exam room. All mobile phones, Apple Watches and mp3 players must be left at home or switched off and zipped in schoolbags. Pupils will NOT be allowed to listen to music during revision time as this is not allowed in external exams. Any pupil who is found to be using a mobile phone or electronic device in an examination room will score zero in that exam and be put in detention.
- ❖ During lunch, pupils should stay away from the B block, the H block and rooms L3 L6 as junior pupils will be doing exams in these areas at this time.
- ❖ If you are absent and miss any exams then you must inform your subject teachers on the first day you return to school.
